## TRAIL ETIQUETTE

#### **ALL USERS**

- Show courtesy to other trail users at all times.
- Use right side of trail.
- Always pass on the left.
- If you pack it in, you pack it out.

### BICYCLISTS

- Yield to pedestrians.
- Give audible warning when passing pedestrians or other cyclists.
- Ride at a safe speed. Slow down and form a single file line in congested conditions, reduced visibility and other hazardous conditions.



### PEDESTRIANS

- Stay on the right side of trail except when passing.
- Watch for other trail users.
- Listen for audible signals and allow faster trail users (runners, cyclists, and rollerbladers) to pass "safely".

### **BIKES-ON-BUSES**

 Grant Transit Authority (GTA) has installed bike racks on the front of all of its buses, providing a convenient way to bike-and-ride. You may load and unload your bicycle at any GTA bus stop.

### DOGS

- Keep dogs on a leash.
- Remove waste from trail. You must have in your possession the equipment necessary pick up or to remove and to properly dispose of any feces. (Ord. 87-7 §1(part), 1987)(Ord. 09-07, 2009)
